- (d) if so, the main places through which the Highway is proposed to be routed; and
- (e) the proposed plan for construction of the Kundannoor Mattakuzhi bypass on NH No.85?

- (a) About 234 Km length of National Highways (NHs) have been constructed/upgraded in Kerala during 2011-12.
- (b) Improvement of about 314 km length of National Highways, Repair and Rehabilitation of cross drainage works, Road safety works etc have been included in the Annual Plan 2012-13 at an outlay of Rs. 347 crore.
