(a) to (c) The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its interim order dated 24.07.2012 in a Special Leave to Appeal (Civil) No. 21339/2011, Ajay Dubey versus National Tiger Conservation Authority & others has banned tourism in core areas of tiger reserves in the country. The matter is sub-judice.
