(c) whether it would have adverse effect on wildlife corridor, tiger reserve and livelihoods of many forest depends;

(d) if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the corrective steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b) Central Government, so far, has not accorded approval to a proposal seeking its prior approval under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 1182.351 hectares of forest land in favour of M/s. Mahan Coal Limited, Singrauli for mining of coal in Mahan Coal Block located in Singrauli district of Madhya Pradesh.
