Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether all cooperative banks in the country have been computerized;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Haryana and the allocations made and spent so far; and
- (c) if not, the time by which all the cooperative banks are likely to be computerized in the country, particularly Haryana?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI NAMO NARAIN MEENA)

(a) to (c): National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has initiated the process of bringing rural Cooperative Credit Structure including State Cooperative Banks (SCBs) and Central Cooperative Banks (CCBs) to the Core Banking Solutions (CBS) platform. NABARD has reported that all CCBs have been advised to be Core Banking Compliant by 31 March 2013 and SCBs to be CBS compliant by 31 December 2012.

NABARD has further reported that all 20 Cooperative Banks (SCB and CCBs) in Haryana have joined the initiative and are scheduled to be CBS compliant by 31 December 2012.
