(a) whether on account of unplanned construction of school buildings under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, the large area of school lands are still lying vacant;

(b) if so, whether the Government proposes to take necessary steps to ensure optimum and systematic use of land by way of conducting a survey of the constructed or under construction school buildings; and

(c) if so, the time by which the said survey is likely to be conducted?

(a) to (c) All States/UTs are being supported under the scheme of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan for creation and augmentation of physical infrastructure in schools including, inter alia, construction of school buildings and additional classrooms. The design, layout and cost of construction of school buildings are decided by the respective States/ UTs. Government of India is not, at present, considering a proposal to undertake a survey of vacant land in government schools.
