- (a) whether the funds under central schemes like Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan and Mid-Day Meal are utilized in Karnataka for Government supported institutions only;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether more than 50 per cent of non-commercial public schools, run by public with Government concurrence are yet to be supported by Government; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d) In the State of Karnataka, funds under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) and Mid-Day Meal (MDM) schemes are being utilized for 46030 Government and 2449 Government aided schools, as per the existing norms of these centrally sponsored schemes. Unaided schools are not covered under these schemes.
