(d) if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the response of the State Governments in this regard ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (DR. CHARAN DAS MAHANT)

(a) & (b): Data on processing of agricultural produces is not centrally maintained by the Ministry. However, M/s Rabo Bank has conducted a study for preparation of Vision Document, suggesting strategy & action plan for Food Processing Sector in India in the year 2005 and has mentioned in the Vision Document that the level of processing of perishable in the country is 6%.

(c): At present there is no such proposal under consideration of the Ministry to encourage creation of producers' societies to fund the food processing sector for creating facilities for value added products.
