- (a) to (b): Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in the Pharma Sector is already permitted as per Consolidated FDI Policy Circular 1 of 2012 notified on 10th April, 2012. The clause 6.2.25 of the Circular states that (i) 100% FDI in Greenfield Pharma is allowed under automatic route; and (ii) 100% FDI in Existing Companies in Pharmaceuticals is allowed under Government route.
