(a) & (b) Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) has planned to induct latest state-of-art exchanges for its landline network including rural areas. BSNL has also planned to induct one million exchange lines based on Next Generation Network (NGN) technology.

(c) & (d) No proposals have been received from State Governments. Based on the requirement received from various field units of BSNL, a tentative plan for deployment/allotment of new exchanges of BSNL is given in the Annexure.
