(a) & (b). The details of target fixed for production of oil during the 11th Five Year Plan (from 2007-08 to 2011-12) and actual oil production are as under:

The reasons for shortfall in crude oil production during 11th plan period are given below:

(i) Decline in several ageing and matured fields.

(ii) Shortage of rigs, inclement of weather in East-coast and prolonged rainy season in North- East.

(iii) Less than anticipated production from Enhanced Oil Recovery (EOR) schemes, (iv) Deferment of production from the new and marginal offshore fields.
