(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Crude oil is imported by Public Sector Oil Companies by way of Term Contracts with National Oil Companies (NOC) of oil producing countries which have exportable surplus of crude oil and the balance requirement is organized through Tenders. Term Contracts are generally finalized for one year period for the grades, quantities and period as required by the Indian refineries.
