(a) whether the Government is considering to make available urea in plenty in drought affected States;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether there has been a demand to reduce the price of urea because of the drought like situation being faced by the country; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (b): The State-wise requirement and availability of Urea in the country during the current year 2012-13 (April`12 to July`12) is at Annexure. As can be seen from the Annexure, the availability of Urea during the current year 2012-13 (April`12 to July`12) was comfortable. There were some instances of local shortage of urea in Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Bihar, Odisha etc. because of lower off-take in the beginning of the season due less rainfall. However, the supply of urea has now been speeded up.

(c) to (d): Department of Fertilizers (DOF) has not received any such reference in this regard from any State.
