A Sub-Committee to the Inter-Ministerial Empowered Committee on` Marine Fisheries (EC) was constituted to inter-alia make suggestions to streamline procedures for grant of Letters of Permission (LOPs) to fish in the Indian Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ). The sub-committee has submitted its report which has been examined from the view point of its practical implementation.
