(a)In Jharkhand State a total irrigation potential of 14.284 th.ha. has been created through projects under Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP) upto March, 2012.

(b)& (c) At present, no such proposal is under consideration in the Ministry of Water Resources.
