- (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps being taken by the Government to obtain the same from European Union and the other western countries?

- (a) Yes, Madam.
- (b) & (c) The European Union (EU) had commissioned a Report in 2010 to analyse the adequacy of protection of personal data provided in India. However, this report had not recommended India to be granted the Data Secure Status. Government through various fora has taken up the matter with the European Union requesting the EU to grant India Data Secure Status, capturing the developments after the amendment in Information Technology Act (2008) and the rules framed thereunder in 2011.
