- (a) whether sugar distribution has been stopped to Below Poverty Line and Antyodaya families of Rajasthan during the last few months due to the pending case of reassessment of margin of levy sugar;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the remedial steps taken in this regard?

- (a): The Government of Rajasthan has informed that it has not stopped sugar distribution to Below Poverty Line (BPL) and Antyodaya families of Rajasthan during the current year due to the pending case of reassessment of margin of levy sugar. Further, the Central Government is allocating levy sugar to the Government of Rajasthan as per its fixed monthly quota on monthly basis for distribution in the PDS.
