(a) & (b): The Government, in the Ministry of Women and Child Development, has begun the implementation of a project namely 'Track Child' in the country, including naxal hit areas, which is aimed at maintaining real time data of all children availing rehabilitation services under the Integrated Child Protection Scheme (ICPS). The software also provides for setting up a National Portal containing identification details of the above mentioned children as well as missing children reported in the Police Stations. The Portal would facilitate matching of the children availing services under the Scheme with the reported missing children.
