(a) to (c) Yes, Sir. A request has been received from Government of Punjab to declare Amritsar as a heritage city. No action on it could be taken as there is no provision for declaration of a city as a heritage city under the provisions of Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites & Remains (AMASR) Act, 1958.
