Answer

THE MINISTER OF WATER RESOURCES(SHRI HARISH RAWAT)

- (a) Overflowing of the river Yamuna during the rainy season causes problems to the people at locations where there is no embankment or where embankment is not high enough to prevent such overflow.
- (b) As informed by National Water Development Agency, Government has not formulated any scheme to divert water of river Yamuna to the Luni river.
