- (d) whether a special emphasis will be given to the rejuvenation of water bodies in the endosulfan affected district of Kasaragod through a separate project; and

## THE MINISTER OF WATER RESOURCES(SHRI HARISH RAWAT)

(a) The scheme of Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of Water Bodies for XII Plan is under consideration. It is proposed to
cover public owned water bodies having CCA of 20 ha. to 2000 ha. The aim is to cover water bodies that are larger than those
covered under the schemes such as Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP) and Mahatma Gandhi National Rural
Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) but smaller than those created under major and medium irrigation project. It is proposed to
include water bodies with water spread areas between 2.5 ha. to 10 ha. to avoid overlapping with other schemes.
