## Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) the area in hectares under banana cultivation in the country;
- (b) whether the Government has any concrete action plan to promote banana plantation and exports; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

## **Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI TARIQ ANWAR)

- (a): As per the latest estimates, the area under banana cultivation in the country is 7817 lakh hectares.
- (b) & (c): In order to enhance production and productivity of horticulture crops in the country including banana, Department of Agriculture & Cooperation, Ministry of Agriculture is implementing Centrally Sponsored Schemes namely Horticulture Mission for North East and Himalayan States (HMNEH), National Horticulture Mission (NHM) and Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY). Under these schemes, assistance is provided for establishment of tissue culture units, area expansion of improved varieties, integrated nutrient & pest management, creation of post harvest management & marketing infrastructure and setting up of processing units.

Agricultural & Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA), Ministry of Commerce provides financial assistance to Public Sector organizations and private exporters for setting up of export oriented state-of-the-art post harvest infrastructure, integrated pack houses at major markets, centres for perishable cargos and walk in type refrigerated container facilities at key airports for promotion of export of perishables including banana.
