Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the current strength of women personnel in the Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF), force-wise and rank-wise;

(b) whether the Government has raised separate women battalions in various CAPFs;

(c) if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether the Government proposes to increase the strength of women personnel in the said forces in the next two years by relaxing the recruitment rules;

(e) if so, the details thereof; and

(f) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to provide additional incentives to women to join the Central Armed Police Forces?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS(SHRI R.P.N. SINGH)

(a): The current strength of women personnel in the Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs), force-wise and rank-wise is given in the enclosed statement at Annexure-I.

(b) & (c): The Government of India has sanctioned separate women Battalions/Companies/ Platoons to CRPF (4 Battalions), SSB (7 Companies) and ITBP (35 Platoons). All these Battalions/Companies/Platoons have been raised, except 1 Battalion in CRPF and 23 Platoons in ITBP.

(d) & (e): The Government, vide Order dated 31.5.2011, has issued instructions to the CAPFs to increase the strength of women personnel to 5% within the next three years. At present, there is no proposal for relaxation in the Recruitment Rules for women in CAPFs.

(f): The details of steps taken by the Government to provide additional incentives to women to join the CAPF are given in the enclosed statement at Annexure-II.
