Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) and other Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) are demanding LPG cylinders at subsidised rates at par with army personnel;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto;
- (c) whether CRPF and other CAPFs have also requested for a hike in their Ration Money Allowance proportionate to the hike in fuel prices; and
- (d) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS(SHRI R.P.N. SINGH)

(a) to (d): The Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) have requested Ministry of Home Affairs to either approach Ministry of Defence to revise the Ration Money Allowance keeping in view the instant price hike on LPG or to approach the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas to supply LPG on subsidized rates to the troops of CAPFs.

Ministry of Defence has been requested to review and revise the rates of Ration Money Allowance.
