Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the funds provided for scholarship to the students of Other Backward Classes (OBCs) are very less as compared to the funds provided for scholarship to the Scheduled Castes (SCs)/Scheduled Tribes (STs)/minority communities;
- (b) whether the Government is planning to increase the amount for post-matric scholarship and construction of hostel buildings; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

- (a) The scholarship scheme for Other Backward Classes (OBCs) is implemented based on funds allocated to the Ministry during the year. The details of funds released under Post-Matric Scholarship Schemes for Other Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Minority Communities during 2011-12 are as under:
- S1. Name of the Scheme $\,$ Rs. in crore $\,$ No.
- 1 Post-Matric Scholarships to the 527.99 students of OBCs
- 2 Post-Matric Scholarships to the 2711.34 students of SCs
- 3 Post-Matric Scholarships to the 865.65 students of STs
- 4 Post-Matric Scholarships to the 362.99 students of Minotiry Communities
- (b) & (c) The budget allocation under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post-Matric Scholarship to the students belonging to OBCs has been enhanced from Rs.135.00 crore in 2009-10 to Rs.625.00 crore in 2012-13.

At present the budget allocation under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Construction of Hostel for OBC Boys and Girls in adequate.
