(a) to (c) : The Department of International Development (DFID) under the Government of United Kingdom has provided financial assistance to the State Governments of Bihar, Madhya Pradesh and Odisha in the health sector which inter-alia, includes assistance for upgradation of hospitals. The World Bank has also provided assistance in form of Ioan to strengthen State health systems. No scheme has so far been formulated for investment by Non-Resident Indians in health sector.
