FREQUENCY OF TRAINS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways are considering the proposal for running Train No. 12939-40, Pune-Jaipur Express seven days a week instead of two days a week;
- (b) if so, the details in this regard and the time by which it is likely to be implemented;
- (c) whether the frequency of the weekly Uttaranchal Express is likely to be increased up to twice a week;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Railways also propose to increase the frequency of Garib Rath between Chennai and Nagercoil by at least twice per week; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the time by any decision is likely to be taken?

Answer

- (a) No, Madam. At present, there is no proposal to increase the frequency of 12939/12940 Pune-Jaipur Express from bi-weekly to daily.
