### Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the details of status of railway projects pending/under implementation regarding the construction of Rail Over Bridges (ROBs) in the State of Bihar including at Digha-Pahlejaghat over the river Ganga in Patna;

(b) whether the said bridge has undergone time and cost overrun;

(c) if so, the reasons therefor and the time by which the project is likely to be completed and made operational; and

(d) the steps taken/being taken by the Railways to complete the aforesaid projects within a stipulated timeframe?

# Answer

### MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI ADHIR RANJAN CHOWDHURY)

### (a):

(i) Construction of 55 nos. of Road Over Bridges (ROBs) have been sanctioned on cost sharing basis in Bihar.

Progress of 55 Nos. of ROBs is as under:-

# 9 Nos. - Work completed fully on both Railway bridge portion and approaches.

# 6 Nos. - Work on Railway Bridge portion completed, work on approaches in progress.

# 40 Nos. - Work is at various stages of progress.

(ii) Foundation and sub-structure of main bridge at Digha-Pahlejaghat over the river Ganga in Patna have been completed. 40% work of steel superstructure has been completed.

Danapur to New station Patliputra (part of this project) has already been inspected by Commissioner of Railway Safety (CRS). 60% approach work of this bridge has also been completed.

(b) & (c): No, Madam. Project is targeted to be completed by March 2015.

(d): Following steps have taken to complete the aforesaid project within the stipulated time frame:

# Regular meeting were conducted at Chief Secretary's level to expedite land acquisition.

- # Tender of steel superstructure was awarded to IRCON, a Govt. of India's Public Sector Unit (PSU).
- # Design & Drawing were finalized by engaging consultant.
- # Railway Board & Planning commission have been apprised regularly for timely arrangement of fund.

# Fabrication workshop and erection work being done from both ends of river Ganga simultaneously.
