- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up modern bus shelters in Kerala with the assistance of the Central Warehousing Corporation;
- (b) if so, the cities proposed to be covered under this project; and
- (c) the time by which it is likely to be implemented?

## **Answer**

- (a): Yes Madam, the Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC) proposes to set up a few bus shelters in Kerala under its Corporate Social Responsibilities programme.
- (b): The Districts of Kochi and Alleppey are to be covered under the project.
- (c): The District Administration has to indentify suitable locations and handover the vacant sites for the construction of bus shelters. The CWC will take six months for construction after the site is handed over to it.
