(a) whether the units/factories engaged in production of edible oil are unable to utilise their production capacity optimally due to shortage of oilseeds; and

(b) if so, the measures taken by the Government to ensure maximum utilisation of the capacity of these companies?

(a) & (b): Yes Madam. In order to meet the domestic demand of edible oils in the country and to ensure maximum utilization of capacity of edible oil units, import of edible oils has been facilitated by reducing import duty on crude and refined oils to zero and 75% respectively. Government has allowed import of edible oils under Open General Licence (OGL). The industrial units are free to import crude or refined oils and do value addition for better capacity utilization.
