(a): The Central Wool Development Board has the following schemes towards development of wool and woollen products:-

(i) Integrated Wool Improvement and Development Programme (IWIDP):-

- # Sheep and Wool Improvement Scheme
- # Angora Wool Development Scheme
- # Pashmina Wool Development Scheme
- # Human Resource Development & Promotional activities.

(ii) Quality Processing of Wool and Woollen Scheme:

- \$ Setting up of Common Facility Centres for all kind of wool and woollen processing activities.

(iii) Social Security Scheme:

- @ Sheep Breeders Insurance Scheme.
- @ Sheep Insurance Scheme.
