- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Details of new greenfield airports approved for development are given at Annexure I.
- (c): Of the fifteen new Greenfield airport projects approved by the Government, six of them at Navi Mumbai and Shirdi (Maharashtra), Mopa (Goa), Kannur (Kerala), Karaikal (Pudduchery) and Kushinagar (Uttar Pradesh) are considered for international operations subject to they having all the required infrastructure facilities and obtaining the prescribed regulatory clearances for such operations.
- (d) & (e): The details of the airports in respect of which the states have requested for upgradation, expansion and modernization are given at Annexure II.
