**Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Union Government has received any project for construction of ring road around Gir forest area in the State of Gujarat;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the said project is being considered for approval by Ministry of Environment and Forests?

**Answer**

(a),(b)&(c) The State Government of Gujarat had submitted a proposal for conservation of Asiatic Lion and construction of Ring Road around the Gir Protected Area System (Gir National Park and Gir, Paniya, Mitiyala and Girnar sanctuaries) in 2009. Subsequently, after a high level meeting in the Ministry of Environment and Forests with the State Government officers, the State Government had submitted a revised proposal for Gir Protected Area System indicating details of Central and State funding for biodiversity conservation and infrastructure development for Rs 262.36 crores. The revised proposal did not include construction of a Ring road around the Gir Protected Area System. No proposal has been received subsequently in the Ministry from the State Government of Gujarat regarding construction of ring road around Gir forest area. Accordingly, no further action is pending with the Ministry of Environment and Forests in this regard.
