- (a) the total fund allocated for the implementation of Nutrient Based Subsidy Scheme;
- (b) The guidelines provided to the farmers about this new scheme; and
- (c) The amount, the Government expects to save from implementation of the said scheme?

- (a): A provision of Rs 28576.12 crores has been made in the BE-2012-13 for payment of subsidy under Nutrient Based Subsidy (NBS) Policy which is applicable to Phosphatic and Potassic (P&K) fertilizers.
- (b): No guidelines have been issued to farmers under NBS Policy. However, the farmers are supposed to pay not more than the printed Maximum Retail Price on each bag of fertilizer.
- (c): The expenditure under the head 'subsidy on P&K fertilizers' for the last five years is as under:
