## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) & (b): 109 new line projects are in progress in various parts of the country which, on completion, will add about 11000 Km of broad gauge lines to the network. Most of these lines are on socio-economic considerations for development of backward, remote, hilly & underdeveloped areas.
- (c): The projects are in various stage of execution. The completion of ongoing projects will depend upon availability of resources. No fixed timeframe can be offered at this juncture.
