- (a) & b): Presently, training to policemen deployed in coastal police stations is imparted by Indian Coast Guard.
- (c) to (d): The Government has decided to set up a National Institute of Coastal Policing with the objective to give comprehensive training to Marine Police personnel for manning the coastal police stations and vessels.
