Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to set up Medical Colleges for Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) on the lines of Armed Forces Medical College in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (c) the time by which such Medical Colleges are likely to be set up in various parts of the country along with the total expenditure likely to be incurred in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI R.P.N. SINGH)

- (a) & (b): The Government has accorded in-principle approval on 22.12.2011 for establishment of a Central Armed Police Forces Institute of Medical Sciences (CAPFIMS), along with 800 Bedded Research & Referral Hospital (500 bedded General Hospital + 300 Bedded Super Specialty Hospital), Nursing College and School of Paramedics, at Maidan Garhi, New Delhi. The estimated cost of the project is Rs. 1537.49 crore. The implementation period of the project is 6 years.
- (c): At present, there is no other proposal for setting up such Medical Colleges in various parts of the Country.
