- (a) whether any proposal for amendment in Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989, with regard to issuance of driving licences to handicapped persons is under consideration of the Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken or proposed to be taken by the Government thereon?

(a) & (c) Detailed procedure for issue of driving license has been laid down in Chapter II of Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989. The Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Bill, 2012 to amend the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, which has been passed by Rajya Sabha and which is presently pending in Lok Sabha, seeks to insert a new Section (3A) in the said Act so as to introduce a definition of 'Carriage for persons with disability'. The Bill also seeks to substitute the existing sub-section (2) of section 10 of the Act to provide that a learner's licence or a driving licence shall also be expressed as entitling the holder to drive a carriage for persons with disability.
