(a) Yes sir.

(b) The Department of Chemicals & Petrochemicals has set up a Scheme of National Awards for Technology Innovation in Petrochemicals and downstream Plastic Processing Industry to incentivize meritorious innovations and inventions in the field of polymeric materials, products, processes and other related areas of national and social importance. The Central Institute of Plastic Engineering & Technology (CIPET) has been designated as the nodal agency for the scheme. Applications/nominations are invited by wide publicity, through advertisements in major newspapers and posting on the website. The entry applications for awards are screened and evaluated by the Expert Committee consisting of the members nominated by the Department and headed by the Directors General, CIPET. Evaluations of the Expert Committee are placed before the Prize Award Committee, which then submits its recommendations on awardees for final approval of Secretary (C&PC).

(c) An outlay of Rs. 63.00 lakh has been allocated to the scheme for the year 2012-13.
