- (c) whether any proposal regarding change in the jurisdiction of above said project due to formation of new districts in Chhattisgarh has been forwarded by the State Government and ;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SMT. RANEE NARAH)

- (a) & (b): The States of Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and Uttarakhand have submitted the proposal for re-organisation of the Integrated Tribal Development Projects in the State.
- (c) & (d): The Government has received the proposals from the State Government of Chhattisgarh for reorganisation of Narayanpur, Bhanupratappur and Kondagaon Integrated Tribal Development Projects (ITDPs) in Bastar-District, after creation of New Districts in the State. Since proposals were incomplete, deficiencies have been communicated to the State Government.
