- (c) the quantum of funds sanctioned, released and utilised by the States for the purpose during each of the last three years and the current year; and
- (d) the other measures taken/being taken by the Government for rehabilitation and upliftment of these tribals?

(a) to (d): No such proposal from States has been received by M/o Tribal Affairs. As per reply received from Department of Land Resources, National Rehabilitation & Resettlement Policy, 2007 (NRRP-2007) has been formulated to address various issues related to land acquisition and rehabilitation & resettlement comprehensively. The provisions of the NRRP-2007 provide for the basic minimum requirements that all projects leading to involuntary displacement must address.
