(a) & (b): The Government has identified the ports of Chennai, Cochin, New Mangalore, Mormugao, Tuticorin and Mumbai for development of cruise tourism. Cruise terminals have already been constructed at Mumbai, Chennai, New Mangalore, Cochin and Tuticorin.

(c) & (d): Yes, Madam. The Government has decided to take steps for setting up a new major port each in Andhra Pradesh and West Bengal.
