(a) to (c): No, Madam. As reported by various major ports in India there is no incident of marine animals dying due to handling and movement of hazardous items at major ports. Handling and movement of cargo is done complying with rules regulations and other international conventions as per IMDG (International Maritime Dangerous Goods) code.
