- (iv) Daria Daulat Bagh, Srirangapatna
- (v) Gumbaj containing Tomb of Tipu Sultan, Srirangapatna.
- (vi) Jumma Masjid, Srirangapatna.
- (vii) Spot where Tipu's body was found, Srirangapatna.

All the above monuments are well preserved and in fairly good condition.

(b) The wall paintings depicting the 2nd Mysore war, commemorating the victory of Tipu Sultan over the British are well preserved at Daria Daulat Bagh, &
