(d) if so, the details thereof along with the reaction of the Government thereto; and

(e) the steps taken/being taken by the Government of in this regard?

(a) Yes, Madam. Regular screening of commercial films was discontinued from April 1, 2012.

(b) It has been decided to utilise Shakuntalam Theatre as a venue for Seminars, Conferences and other trade promotion activities.

(c) We have received about 25 representations from some members of public against the decision.

(d) & (e) As per Terms and Conditions for lease of Pragati Maidan to ITPO, Shakuntalam Theatre as a part of Pragati Maidan can only be used for Seminars, Conferences and other trade promotion activities.
