- (a): The preparation of the Perspective Plan for the overall Delhi Mumbai Industrial Corridor (DMIC) region is complete. Land acquisition process is in progress in the States of Haryana, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat and Maharashtra and master planning has started in Uttar Pradesh. The Financial and Institutional Structure for development of the industrial cities in DMIC region was approved by the Government of India on 15th September, 2011. The cities would be launched with the development of townships of 25-50 sq km which are envisaged to be completed by the end of 2018.
