**Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:**

- (a) the present status of proposed international airport at Jewar, Greater Noida in Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) whether the Group of Ministers (GoMs) has submitted their report in this regard;
- (c) if so, the details thereof including the steps taken/being taken by the Government in light of the recommendations/observations of the GoMs and the likely expenditure on the said project;and
- (d) the time by which the said airport is likely to be set up and the other measures taken by the Government for the expeditious implementation of the said project?

**Answer**

(a) to (d): Govt. of India had received a proposal from State Govt. of Uttar Pradesh (GoUP) for setting up of a Greenfield International airport at Jewar (Greater Noida), in year 2002. The proposal was considered by the Union Cabinet and then referred to a Group of Ministers (GoM) for looking into the legal and other related aspects of the matter. An independent traffic study was conducted as per the decision of the GoM. However in the mean time, GoUP has decided not to go ahead with the said proposal.
