- (c) & (d) The Ministry of Rural Development has finalized a proposal regarding setting up of a mechanism for Concurrent Evaluation based on management of a Concurrent Evaluation Network (CENET) to facilitate systematic rapid and rigorous concurrent evaluation of all the programmes of the Ministry.
