- (c) the corrective steps taken by the Railways to ensure that the timely and satisfactory replies are tendered to the queries made by public representatives?

- (a) Indian Railways maintain the records of representations received from people's representatives relating to proposals regarding conversion of unmanned level crossings.

Once the competent authority approves the reply, the same is forwarded to the concerned public representative within a reasonable time.
