(a) to (c): 'Sports' being in the State list under the Seventh Schedule of the Constitution of India, responsibility for making adequate budgetary allocation for sports is that of the respective State Governments. As far as the Union Government is concerned, allocation of funds for sports is made keeping in view the overall budgetary allocation and inter-se priorities of different sectors.

The Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports takes up the matter from time to time with the Planning Commission and the Ministry of Finance for adequate budgetary allocation for sports.
