- (a) The details of natural gas pipeline projects under-construction in the country as provided by Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) both in public and private sector are at Annexure.
- (b) to (d) The authorizations granted by the Ministry for the following four natural gas pipelines to Reliance Gas Transportation Infrastructure Limited (RGTIL) were rescinded with effect from 24.09.2012; due to non-submission of Performance Bank Guarantee and non-completion of pipeline projects within the stipulated period in violation of Entry No. 7 of terms and conditions of authorization:
- 1. Chennai-Bangalore-Mangalore Pipeline
- 2. Chennai-Tuticorin Pipeline
- 3. Kakinada-Basudebpur-Howrah Pipeline
- 4. Kakinada-Chennai Pipeline
